**Naturopath Prince George - Typical visits** - Since the physician will take an in depth account of your current and previous health concerns, your first appointment with a Naturopath could take up one and half hours long. Succeeding visits will vary between twenty minutes to an hour, depending on the medical professional you're dealing with and your specific health concerns. With the patients' input, a tailored therapy plan might be introduced to be able to help facilitate reaching the clients' health goals.

The CAND payment schedule is based on a fee of \$125 - \$180 per hour. First appointments are approximately 1-1½ hours long with subsequent visits ranging from 20 - 60 minutes.
